- The Huron Health System includes the Alexandra Marine and General Hospital (AMGH) in Goderich and the South Huron Hospital Association (SHHA) in Exeter.
- The combined revenue for the two hospitals is just under \$44M.
- Across the two hospitals, there are approximately 360 employees, more than 35 physicians and specialists, and more than 200 volunteers working together to meet the health care needs of our communities.
- Our hospitals receive between 22,000 25,000
 Emergency Department visits annually and support more than 19,000 patient days each year.
